locally and globally.

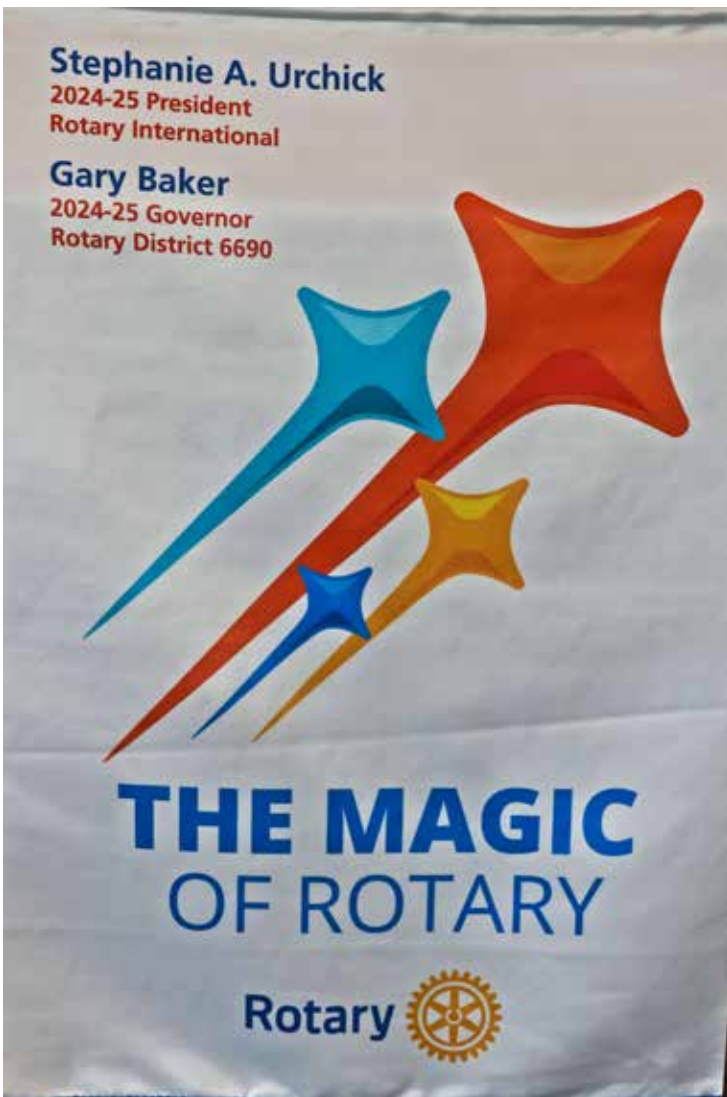


Julie is passionate about children and
