As a reminder, the intent of this award is to recognize a Rotarian who has exemplified Rotary’s motto, “Service Above Self” through recent Club involvement.

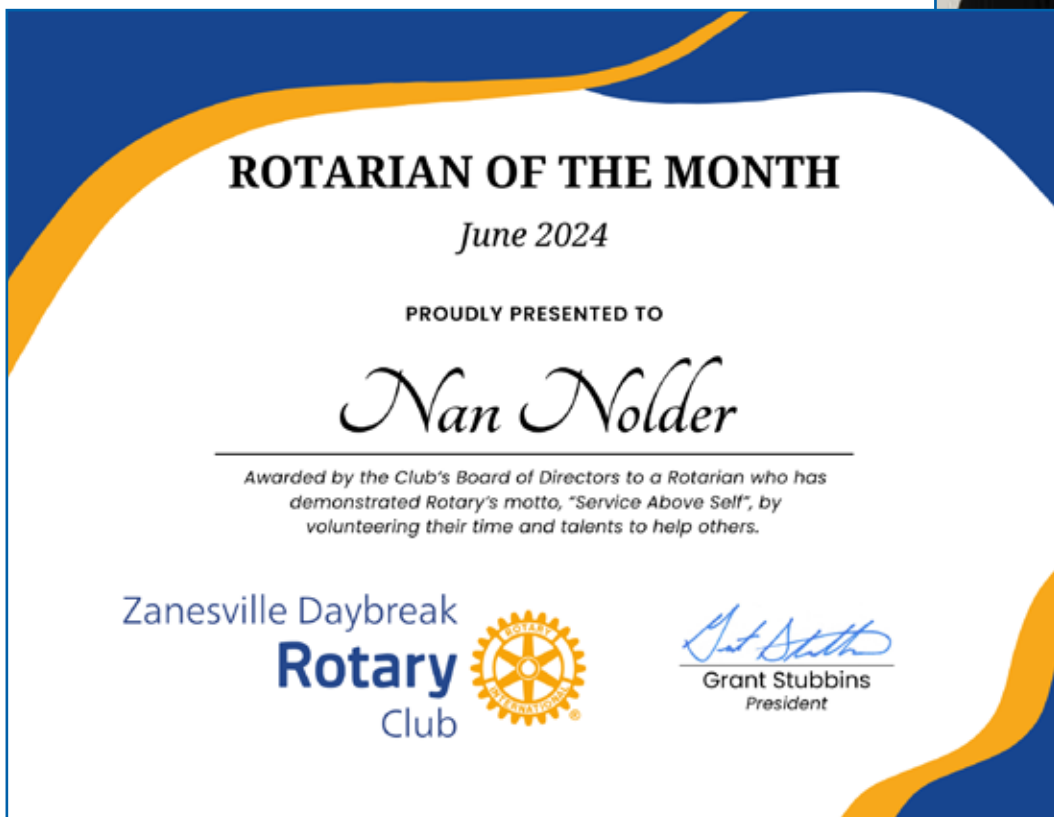
The winner will be featured in our Club newsletter and receive free breakfast for four weeks.

1. What We do (In Park Programs, Partnership Programs, Community Outreach, Sustainability).

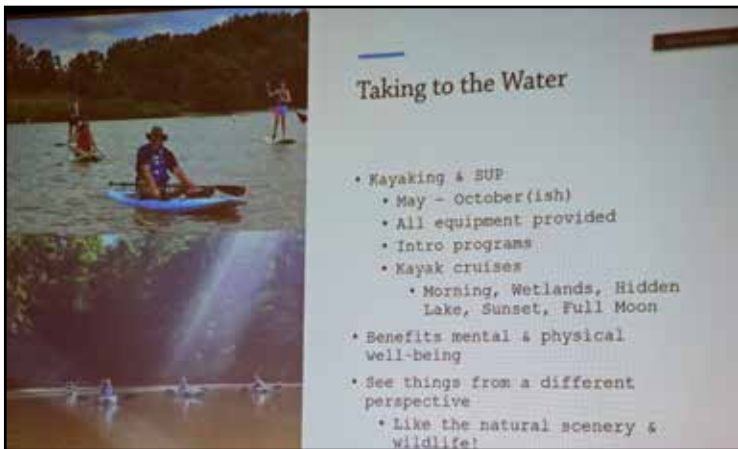
2. Previews of New and Coming Attractions (OuterSpatial App, Camp Store Renovation, Chimney Swift Tower, New Nature Center)
