Dana Matz announced that AMG Vanadium will begin construction of a new state of the art facility in the East Pointe Industrial Park. AMG Vanadium is the world's leading provider of residue spent catalyst recycling and metal reclamation services. This will be their second site in Ohio with the other being in Cambridge. The first phase of construction, which is expected to begin later this summer will be completed the second half of 2020 and focus on a raw material storage building and a multiple-hearth roaster. Overall project completion, including construction of the ferroalloy production facility, is expected in 2021. The facility will create approximately 100 new production and management jobs in addition to 500 to 600 temporary jobs during construction. A great win for the Zanesville area and central Ohio.
