Like many cities in Ecuador, Riobamba has a near constant temperature year-round, with a wet and dry season. It has an altitude of over 9,000 feet and closeness to Chimborazo give the city a cool climate year-round, with temperatures averaging around 55 degrees.

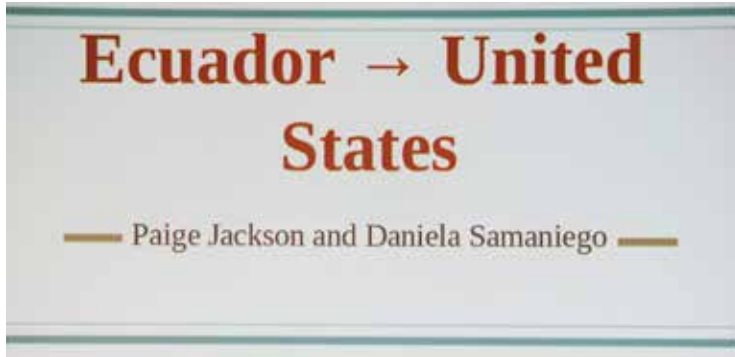
