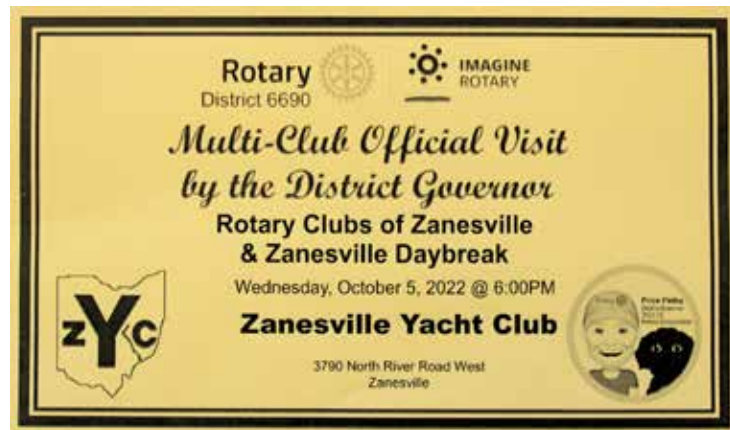

He indicated that he tries to instill fun and a love for learning with all who are involved in the



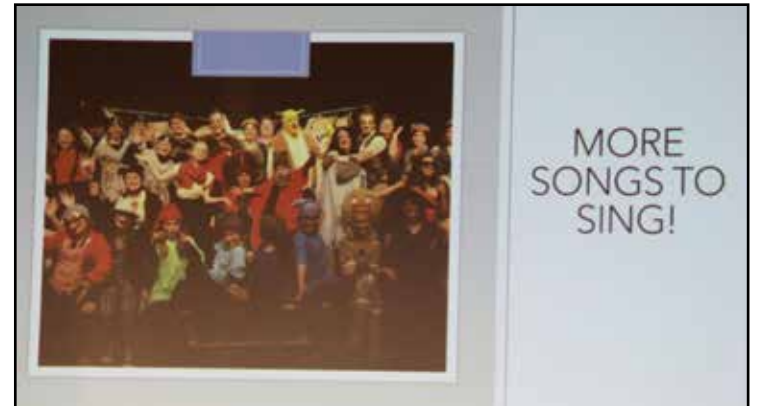
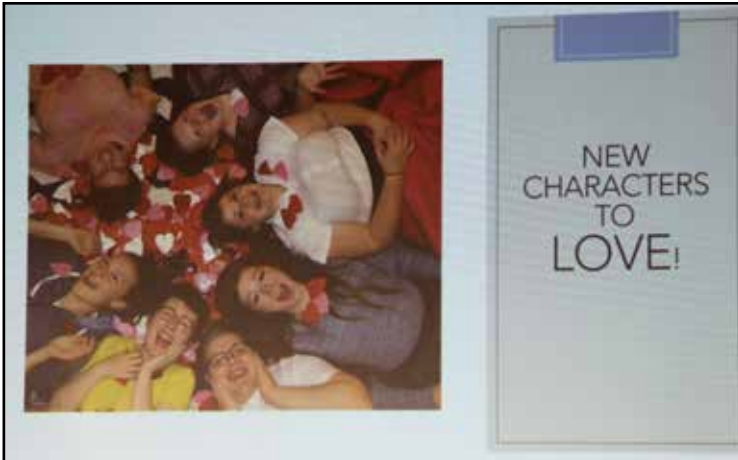
Zane Trace Players. His hope is that people who were in the audience will later think of laugh about something in the play. He knows that if that happens, he has done his job.
