

- Avon is still the traditional direct selling model.
- Avon has field sales representative (re-branded) Avon Ambassadors
- Avon also has an Ecommerce site for Direct ordering, Avon.com



- YTD, we have fulfilled 1,223,000 orders for Ambassadors and Direct Avon Customers. That is 22,000,000 pieces picked and 1,400,000 cartons shipped!
  - Average of 22,000 cartons every two weeks
  - Average of 1,200,000 pieces every two weeks
  - Average of 12,000 orders processed every two weeks
- On the LG, H&H side of the business we are shipping to retailers like, Amazon, Walgreens, CVS, Sephora, and Ulta and more.
