In June of 2019, he was assigned additional responsibilities at the cooperative when named (interim) Director of Member Services.

Gary is active with the Newark Midland Theatre Association Board of Trustees serving as president from 2020-2022 and he is a board member of the Licking County Board of Developmental Disabilities. Gary has been

1987. He served as club president in the Rotary year 2011-2012.
