Speaker: President Elect Marisa Myers introduced today's speaker, Patrick McClain with the Franklin County Mental Health and Addiction Crisis Center. Patrick was excited to share that the new Center was currently under construction. The proposed 72,000 sf facility is planned to be completed in 2024 and built to serve all of Franklin County. The facility will also feature on-site medical services as well as pharmacy services. It will accommodate scheduled as well as walk-in patients, individuals or families. New will be the use of an alternative emergency response line using a 988 number for mental health emergencies. Considerable funding is coming from local hospital systems to support the move of mental health patients and services to this new facility rather than taxing emergency rooms. This will simultaneously provide better and more efficient care to both types of patients while ensuring specialists are identified and engaged quicker when needed.
