Mr. Oster stated the purpose of ODOT is to provide a transportation system that is safe, accessible, well maintained, and well-positioned for the future. His district has 330 employees who take care of highway management (from landscaping mitigation, bridges, drainage, snow removal, potholes and pavement integrity to numerous capital projects). Mr. Oster also said ODOT is only in charge of state roads, not city or county roads. It was a fascinating program and I'm sure we all learned something new.
