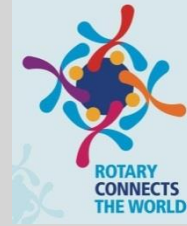

Our Club has established a small emergency task force to help when called to duty. Our Rotary Hotline is available 24/7 if you are in need of emergency assistance: 614-895-1700.

Task force duties are focused on delivering emergency medicines, provisions and providing transportation for medical appointments. Our goal is to promptly return calls.

In addition, we are grateful for WARM supplying Star House with food if the need arises. Ellen Cathers will inform Star House management to call our Rotary Hotline if they need food---immediately after we are notified, we will relay the details and urgency from Star House directly to WARM.

We will also invite our Club members to make a financial donation to WARM to help alleviate the +220% growth in requests for emergency food, and double the number of new clients in the past two weeks due to the pandemic.

Our community is Blessed by WARM, the compassion and amazing leadership of fellow Rotarian, Scott Marier and his staff!

Your board of directors is now meeting though a conference call weekly to make sure any needs of our members, programs and other needs of the community are met without delay.

One item that was discussed at the first of these weekly meetings was the Harris-Askins and any possible needs of our residents.

President Tom Shaver has put together a special Rotary COVID19 Task Force to be available for needs of our membership, Harris Askins House and other community needs.

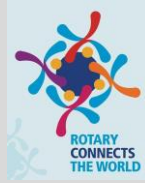
Your message will be sent to the Task Force for dispatch and disposition.
