The South Oldham Rotary Club has generously donated \$5,000 to the Oldham County Early Childhood Development organization in support of Dolly Parton's Imagination Library. Currently, 1,503 children—62% of those eligible in Oldham County—are enrolled in the program. In addition to supporting Imagination Library, the organization also sponsors Little Free Libraries throughout the county, ensuring more children have access to books.

The Rotary Club of Prospect Goshen also contributed a \$5,000 donation, further strengthening the program's impact on young readers.
