#### About David Eager:

David Eager will give an update on the state of the pension and reform efforts.

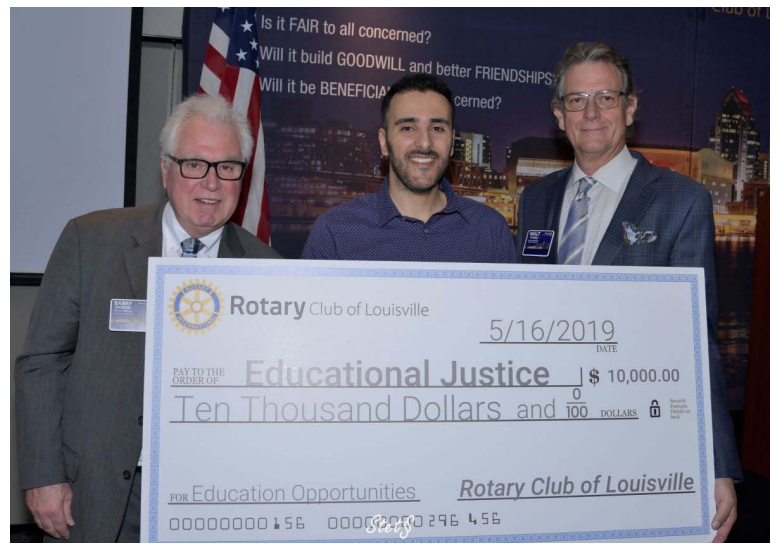
As Executive Director, David Eager is responsible for the overall management of more than 245 employees and the numerous operations of the Systems, which currently has over 379,000 members and \$17 billion in assets. He represents the retirement systems on public policy matters, including issues before the Kentucky General Assembly, and serves as the KRS liaison to Executive Branch agencies and the general public.

Mr. Eager was originally appointed to the KRS Board of Trustees in April, 2016 by Governor Bevin and was elected Chair of the Investment Committee. In August, 2016, he was named Interim Executive Director and served in that capacity until April, 2018 when the Board voted to make him the Executive Director.

## Rotary Meeting Recap- May 16, 2019

Moshe Ohayon, Founder of Educational Justice, presented an extraordinary evolution of what he began as a tutoring center and developed into a model for leveling the socio-economic playing field in higher education. While transitioning a traditional tutoring center into more of a tutoring resource and classroom-based model for under-privileged students, Moshe made a critical discovery; the students' community-service assignments (used for their college applications) were menial tasks that under-utilized their capabilities. Moshe saw an opportunity and developed Educational Justice Activists as an educational honor society pairing 9th and 5th grade students, allowing the accomplishments of older students to become a service to younger students. This new model has proven its worth in increased Ivy League scholarships for under-privileged students and became an award winner at the Harvard Social Entrepreneurship Conference. 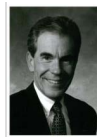

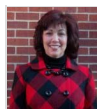
