The Middle TN Council (MTC) is a separate entity from the National Boy Scouts America and it oversees its own Governance. The MTC also has four Camping Facilities—Boxwell Reservation in Lebanon TN, Grimes Canoe Base in Linden TN, Latimer Reservation in Spenser TN and Parish Reservation in Walling TN. Camp Boxwell celebrates its 100th year of operation this year.
