Pictured above DG Michael Babb MD, President Greg Kelso, and Assistant DG Jane Jennings. Governor Babb gave an inspiring presentation on the evolution of Rotary over its 116 year history. Rotary began as a networking organization for business men in Chicago and other US cities then quickly evolved into an international organization of business owners and professionals dedicated to service. Membership eligibility was expanded to include women in the late 1980's and Rotary grew into today's organization with 1.2 million members in 200 countries and regions. Rotary in the twenty-first century is becoming much more diverse and inclusive and its focus continues to be on service. Dr. Babb described how service creates a ripple effect that may touch individuals far removed from an initial act of kindness. He complimented the local club on its longstanding impact in Lawrenceburg and Lawrence County.

During his presentation, Dr. Babb presented a District 6760 Trailblazer Award to Lawrenceburg Rotarian Jane Jennings. Jane was one of the first women to become Lawrenceburg Rotarians in 1990 and is currently serving as an Assistant Governor in our Rotary District. Jane introduced the program and presented Governor Babb with a ceremonial coonskin cap at the conclusion of his presentation.
