Deputy Commissioner of TN Dept of Environment and Conservation and the Bureau of State Parks, Jim Bryson spoke on Friday, February 25th, about the importance of Tennessee State Parks. He highlighted deferred maintenance projects and monies appropriated to complete \$84 million worth of back logged projects for all of TN State Parks and how they will be completed over the next few years. \$580K of the maintenance back log is directly related to David Crockett State. The visions of these programs are looking to improve the public natural experience in perpetuity for the TN Parks system. Tennessee State Parks had \$2 billion economic impact on our state last year, those dollars are visitors that come to enjoy parks like Crockett and spend money and time in our community as well. TN Parks are one of only seven states, that are all free to the public and the TN Parks are rated in the top four nationally.
