Program— Circuit Court Judge Chris Sockwell



Picture above President Greg Kelso, Judge Chris Sockwell and Rotarian Olivia White. Christopher Sockwell is a Circuit Court / Chancery Court Judge for the State of Tennessee. Chris was appointed by Gover- in Florence AL at the Marriott. nor Bill Haslam in 2018 to take the place of retired Judge Robert L. Jones in the 22nd district of Giles, Lawrence, Maury, and Wayne Counties. There are 4 Judges currently in this district with a fifth Judge being proposed but the Legislature has not approved this proposal. Chris noted that the 22nd district Judges must serve both the Circuit Court and Chancery Court as other districts may split these duties. The Circuit Court Judges are elected every 8 years and Chris's term is due on the 2022 election cycle. Tennessee Appellate and Supreme Court Judges are appointed by the Governor and are only voted on in an up or noll basis during their cycle. Chris clarified there had been only one Judge that had been voted noll in the history of this system. Chris explained that one must ask for permission to appeal a case to the Tennessee Appellate/Supreme courts. Chris also gave and interesting history of the Lawrence County Judgeship starting with Judge Joe Ingram, Bud Harwell and others that have served Lawrence County.
