Pictured above President Jason Armbruster Speaker Nicole Miller and Speaker Trea Dunnivant from the Lawrence County Substance Abuse Coalition (LCSAP) MS Miller, who is the Drug Endangered Children Coordinator, discussed Grace House which is a pilot program of LCSAP. According to Miller, children who come into custody often have only the clothes on their back and may have to remain at a police station or DCS office until arrangements can be made for their care. The goal of Grace House is to provide a welcoming place for these children to rest and temporary shelter until more permanent arrangements can be made. Grace House is hoping to begin formal operations later this month and will provide warm meals, hygiene items, fresh clothes, and other resources to meet their needs. It is located in a dedicated area at the LCSAP office on Deller Street in Lawrenceburg.

According to Mr. Dunnivant, LCSAP began as an education resource on drug related issues for the local community. Its mission has grown and the coalition is now able to assist in guiding individuals who need assistance due to drug related issues toward services that are available. Dunnivant has been the coalition's director since July, 2022 after serving for several years as the organization's Youth Engagement Coordinator.
