



Dr. Lorie Jones, Director of the MBA Program at the University of Tennessee Southern in Pulaski, presented an interesting program at the Lawrenceburg Rotary Club on Friday, November 11, 2022. Dr. Jones is a Lawrenceburg native who spent over twenty five years in local industry before becoming a full time professor at U T Southern. The University of Tennessee merged with Martin Methodist College in 2021with enrollment in Pulaski growing from under 500 to approximately 1000 undergraduate and graduate students from a thirteen county area in Southern Middle Tennessee. U T Southern offers Masters Degrees in Criminal Justice and Business (MBA) at its Pulaski campus. Dr. Jones discussed the benefits for individuals who earn their MBA as well as for employers who hire MBA graduates. In addition to onsite classes, area residents can complete 49% their MBA studies at the Lawrence County Higher Education Center in Lawrenceburg and can also study through distance learning. Tuition is slightly under \$15,000 for the 30 credit hour basic MBA program.
