The Lawrenceburg / Lawrence County Emergency Management Agency plans for and supports organizations responding to emergencies and other incidents that require a multi-agency effort. Barnett had served as Deputy Director for a number of years and became EMA Director upon Joe Baxter's retirement in late 2020.

Shelton discussed facilities available in the Emergency Operations Center at the Lawrenceburg City Administration Building as well as mobile command posts available for on-site incident management. EMA conducts training for numerous agencies in Incident Command, Hazardous Materials Operations, and other subjects. Barnett also described EMA's support role for several incidents including weather related events, search and rescue operations, communication outages and Covid-19 vaccination efforts. for next year's fall term. Campus facilities are currently being upgraded with building renovations. Development of a pre-engineering program is planned for the future.
