



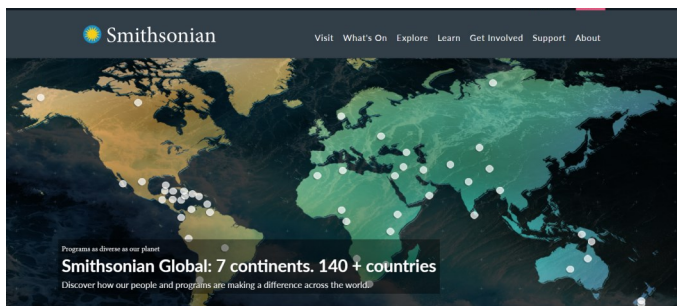

Keestone's Stone Theatre and other facilities are ideal for special functions including proms, weddings, fund raisers, and similar events. MS Gilbreath spoke about the theatrical movie that was shot at the Resort in January. "Christmas At Keestone" is a feel good story that will premier in October, and a planned sequel is scheduled for production later this year
