Picture above Rotarian Olivia White, Speaker Claudia Oakes, and President Jason Armbruster. Claudia Oakes presented an interesting first person account of her career with world class museums. Ms. Oaks grew up in Giles County, earned a four year degree in Memphis at what is now Rhodes College and, after spending some time in Europe, located in Washington, DC in 1969 to began her career with the Smithsonian • Institution. She described her participation in a four year project that expanded the Smithsonian's small aviation exhibit into what is now Smithsonian's Air and Space Museum. MS Oakes worked for 21 years at the Smithsonian and became the first woman to rise to the rank of Curator at the Air and Space Museum. After leaving the Smithsonian, she held responsible positions at museums in Milwaukee, Salt Lake City, Long Island, and Rome, Georgia. MS Oakes related several personal stories that taught her the "Power of Object" and "Power of Place" when creating museum programs and exhibits. During her long career, she met many of the women who made history in early aviation and other notable people including General Jimmy Doolittle, Clint Eastwood, the Secretary General of the United Nations, and the King and Queen of Norway. MS Oakes returned to Pulaski for retirement in 2012.
