Rotary Announces "Books For Babies" Program at STRHS

The Lawrenceburg Rotary Club announced implementation of its "Books For Babies" program in cooperation with Southern Tennessee Regional Health System (Lawrenceburg) on Thursday, October 19, 2023. Lawrenceburg Rotarians delivered the first of 300 bundles of children's books that will be presented to mothers of new born children as they leave the hospital. Each gift wrapped bundle contains three books with a card expressing Lawrenceburg Rotary's investment in them and the community.

According to Rotary President Tiffany Cope, Basic Education and Literacy is one of Rotary International's seven areas of focus and Lawrenceburg's "Books For Babies" program is the local club's effort to address this channel of service. Books were purchased locally through Paper and Thread gift shop and Lawrenceburg Rotarians bundled these into attractive packages on Monday evening for delivery to the hospital on Thursday. The local hospital normally delivers between 250 and 275 babies each year and this year's program will support that number. The 2023 "Books For Babies" program is the first of what is planned to be an ongoing project of the Lawrenceburg Rotary Club.

Rotary President Tiffany Cope presented the books and Hospital CEO Mike Howard accepted on behalf of STRHS. New mother Carrissa Croft and Renleigh Brewer were the first recipients of a Books for Babies bundle.
