Ms. Christian is with the Tennessee Suicide Make Ups—Fair Exec Comm 01/20-Jason Armbruster, John Prevention, a statewide organization that is working to eliminate Beasley, Scott Beasley, Heath Hill, Pat Hollman, Patty Hollthe stigma of suicide. Nationally, over 1.9 million people attempt suicide each year and there were nearly 50 thousand reported deaths by suicide in 2022. According to Ms. Christian, suicide is the most preventable cause of death IF we are educated and aware of Upcoming Rotary Events what the risk factors and warning signs are. Her organization is working to provide awareness and training in Suicide Prevention, Intervention, and Postvention. The network is grant funded and training is provided free of charge. Ms. Christian went on to describe some of the risk factors for suicide, the availability of training, and contact information for those who might be or have a family member who might be at risk. 
