Mike became CEO at the local hospital in late 2022 after working for 20 years at Lifepoint Hospitals Florence location. Lifepoint gave him the choice of managing any of several facilities and Mike chose Lawrenceburg because he wanted to help the hospital address several issues that are common to small community hospitals. In the past sixteen months, STRHS has invested 3.4 million dollars in surgical and other equipment and is currently filling staff positions with quality personnel who are wishing to stay or return home to Lawrence County. According to Mike, STRHS Lawrenceburg currently has a payroll in excess of 26 million dollars and has been recognized by its parent corporation for Operational Excellence. As a “for profit” hospital, STRHS pays over 4 million dollars in local taxes and provides sponsorships and in kind support for numerous community organizations including the Lawrence County School System, Rotary, and the Middle Tennessee District Fair.

In response to a question from the floor, Mr. Howard discussed the impact of Maury Regional Hospital’s announced plan to build a satellite medical center in Lawrenceburg. He described the adverse impact that similar facilities have had on local hospitals in surrounding communities including limited or no availability of after hours healthcare and advanced procedures in those communities. He noted that Maury Regional is classified as a “not for profit” hospital and is therefore exempt from paying local taxes.
