Devin is the Director of the Franklin Rodeo which, except for Covid, has been in continuous operation since 1949. The rodeo became sanctioned by the Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association (PRCA) in 2001 which is recognized as the big leagues in professional rodeo. Franklin Noon Rotary has partnered with J-Bar-J Rodeo which also produces the National Finals Rodeo in Las Vegas as well as other top rodeo events. J-Bar-J and other professional partners produce the actual rodeo while the Rotary Club coordinates and manages promotion, ticket sales, sponsorships, and everything that happens in the seating and other public areas. The Rotary Club’s unofficial mission is to “Put on the best rodeo east of the Mississippi”. Rodeo proceeds are invested in community projects of the Franklin Noon Rotary Club.

This year’s event will be held on May 16 – 18 at the Williamson County Agricultural Park, and will also feature a downtown parade on May 11 and family night on May 15 where youngsters can meet the cowboys, and rodeo clowns; and also participate in special kid friendly events.
