Wade Pettus with Axe Kicking and Escape From Warehouse 1 showed a video of his participation in the World Axe Throwing Championship in Tulsa and described how the event is staged and scored. He also discussed his Escape From Warehouse 1 facility in Loretto. He founded the business in 2020 and has opened a second location in Florence.

Axe Throwing, as the name implies, consists of throwing axes at a target with a bullseye scoring six points and outer rings scoring 5, 4, 3, 2, and 1 points respectively. In competition, a round consists of ten throws in one on one competition with the highest cumulative score winning the round. Escape rooms "lock" a group of people in a closed room and participants have to find clues and solve puzzles to find their way out. Both activities are family friendly and are a lot of fun. More
