Dr. Claudia Williamson Kramer is the Probasco Distinguished Chair of Free Enterprise and Professor of Economics at the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga. She is also the Director of the Center for Economic Education.

Her main research interests lie at the intersection of applied economic development and political economy. She currently serves as an editor for the Journal of Institutional Economics, on the editorial board of Public Choice, on the board of trustees for the Southern Economic Association and served as the 2022-2023 President of the Association of Private Enterprise Education (APEE). She has served on the U.S. Commission on Civil Rights Mississippi Advisory Committee and is on the board of fellows for the Institute of American Civics at the University of Tennessee.
