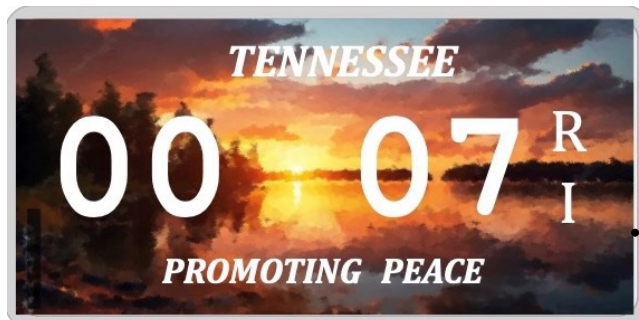
Peace License Plate to Benefit Tennessee Rotarians

New Peace License Plate to Benefit Tennessee Rotarians



An initiative by Rotary District 6760 to have a specialty plate dedicated to Peace has been approved by the TN State Legislature and the campaign to get 1,000 registered motorists signed up is underway. Here are the details:

1. The first year's \$35 will be covered by donations from the Districts. The goal is for \$35,000 to be donated from Club Foundations so that no one has to pay the \$35 the first year.
2. You don't have to be a Rotarian to have the plate, which is a big deal. Anyone can sign up for the plate and the money still comes to the Rotary Districts of Tennessee.
3. This needs to be accomplished by June 1, 2024.
