Harbor Safe House and Advocacy Center is a non-profit organization that provides a safe haven for victims of domestic violence and their children. Lydia Brannon was the presenter at this week's Rotary meeting. Harbor Safe House offers a variety of services to its clients, including:

- *24-hour crisis hotline
- * Temporary housing (typically 12-16 weeks)
- * Counseling
- * Legal assistance
- * Childcare
- * Job training
- * Financial assistance

The shelter also offers a variety of support groups and educational programs for its clients. These programs help victims to understand the dynamics of domestic violence, develop coping skills, and build a plan for their future.

The shelter provides a safe place to stay, the help they need to rebuild their lives, and the hope for a better future. They recently purchased a home that will be their new shelter location. They will be able to serve up to 20 clients at a time compared to a maximum of 12 at their former location.

There are many ways to help Harbor Safe House and the victims of domestic violence that it serves. You can adopt a room at the new shelter by providing essentials such as sheets, mattresses, and other items that clients will need or contribute financially.
