Deborah was district governor in 2017-2018, served as Rotary Leadership Institute Chair from 2018-2020, and is currently District Rotary Foundation chair.

Other Rotary activities include serving as a Mid-South PETS trainer; session coordinator and recorder at various Zone Institutes; and trainer for District Governor-elects, District Governors, and their Partners at several Zone Institutes. 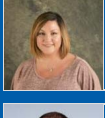
