This past Tuesday we had the pleasure of meeting Hailey Johnston and hear about the amazing organization she leads - Project Free to Fly. Founded in 2013, it specializes in helping women in crisis recovery by teaching sewing skills in a life supporting environment.

With so many in need, it is amazing to see such a strong program flourishing in Cleveland. Project Free 2 Fly works with rehabilitation programs in our area to identify women who are ready to make the move from recovery to a sustainable life. Many women leave rehabilitation programs with no home, no car, no bank account, and no job. Free 2 Fly acts as a bridge between recovery and sustainability.

We hire women and teach them the skills they need to manufacture the products sold in our shop and online. Women at Free 2 Fly start on simple products and eventually graduate to more complicated designs and materials. While learning to sew, women are learning the skills needed to be productive and valuable community members.

Participants are provided with mentoring, counseling services, and life skills training. Each participant is also paired with a mentor with whom they meet weekly to talk about personal circumstances, financial decisions, family challenges, or any number of issues that impact the whole person.
