The camp's 200+ acres includes a campus with nice cabins (central heat and air, carpet, and bunk-beds), a 150 person capacity dining hall, magnificent views from the beautiful Emmaus Chapel (holds 150+), outdoor worship areas, group fire circles, small lake, and cold mountain stream (Rock Creek).
