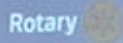
Today we heard from Deborah Alexander-Davis, District Rotary Foundation Chair. She is a member of the Rotary Club of Kingston, Tennessee. Deborah spoke today on the Rotary Foundation and highlighted some of the success of our club here in Cleveland.

Since Rotary of Cleveland has started there have been 85 Paul Harris Fellows, 6 benefactors (\$1,000 left in estate), 4 bequest society (\$10,000 left in estate), and 8 major donors (\$10,000 or more over a lifetime.) The club has given \$853,008 overall since the club was formed. Last year there was \$67,916 in total AF contribution, \$539 per capita, 127 EREY members, 120 sustaining, 7 PHS eligible members, and \$73.57 per capita to polio eradication. Banners the Rotary Club of Cleveland will be receiving are the TRF 100% foundation Giving, TRF Every Rotarian Every Year Club, and we will be receiving the End Polio Now Foundation Award.

- ✓ \$539 AF per capita (district \$274 per capita)
- ✓ 127 EREY Mbrs (any amount to AF) - up from 124 in 20-21
- ✓ 120 Sustaining Mbrs (\$100+ to AF) - up from 116 in 20-21
- ✓ 7 PHS Eligible Members (\$1000+ yearly to any fund)
- ✓ \$73.57 per capita to Polio Eradication (\$90.07 District per capita)
