November 22 was a pleasant and appropriate deviation from our traditional Rotary programs as we heard from Pastor Betsy Denton of Broad Street United Methodist Church. She delivered an inspiring Thanksgiving message challenging us on several fronts. When she called for a poll of what everyone was thankful for, some of the shout-outs included family, friends, health, job - and perhaps the most important - Jesus Christ.

Pastor Denton spoke of living a life with a "Perspective of Gratitude." She quoted from I Thessalonians 5:18, as Paul challenged the church at Thessalonica to, "be thankful in all circumstances," whether rich or poor, in health or sickness, or good times or bad.

Pastor Denton asked, "It's good to be thankful when things are going good, but what happens when things are not going your way? The Apostle Paul learned to be thankful in all situations...he said, I have learned to content in all circumstances."

"You have to be intentional to be grateful in all circumstances," she continued. "Thanksgiving is the time to ask, 'Have I taken an inventory of what I have, of the good things in my life?' As the old hymn goes, 'Count your blessings and name them one by one.'"

Pastor Denton concluded her message with a prayer and the question, "What if we treated everyday as if it were Thanksgiving? Start by taking inventory of those blessings that we sometimes take for granted."
