Willowbend Farms works to fight for and restore the lives of survivors of human trafficking

For the Rotary Club of Cleveland's September 20th program, the founder of Willowbend Farms, Sarah McKinnis presented the affect her organization is making on Bradley County and surrounding communities. She was excited to share that her nonprofit organization was just awarded Tennessee's Governor's Excellence Award, earned by nonprofits that significantly impact the lives of Tennesseans.

Willowbend Farms works to fight for and restore the lives of survivors of human trafficking, sexual exploitation, and sexual violence. Sarah shared with us the number of amazing individuals, such as our own Mayor Brooks, that came together in creating the task force that makes the program a success. In fact, it has been such a great success that it has set a blue print for other communities that have started their own task forces and coalitions because of what was started here in Bradley County.

They started with 1 county and are now serving 23. There have also been 6 regional task forces that have blossomed off of what Bradley County achieved. Sarah beamed that "this award not only belongs to Willowbend, but all of Bradley County."

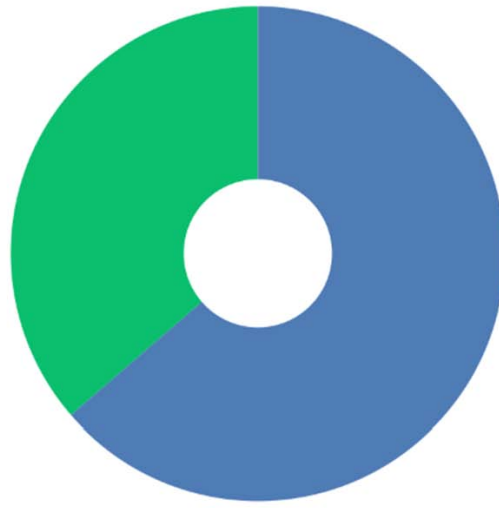
Michael Reed, Sr Vice President at Southeast Bank, is proposed for membership by Lyle Swartzel.
