He said projects are proposed for the center, and the center creates and implements work plans to conduct the research. The researchers look at positive controls, negative controls and neutral controls. When the research is complete, it is often published by the UT Extension Service, with some published in other venues, he said. The center gets much of its funding from the federal Department of Agriculture, but with funding now frozen, no new projects will be planned until the funds are released, he said.
