### Clean Up

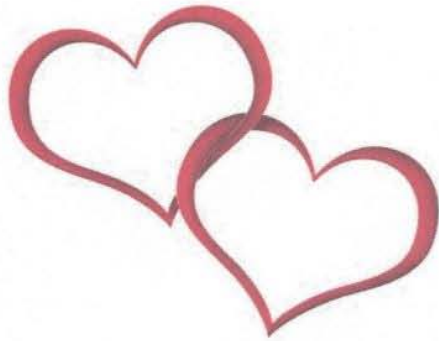

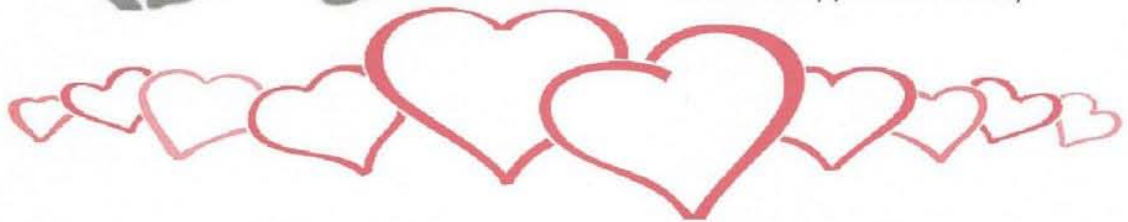

## PREVENTION COALITION HELPS TO STOP ADDICTION

The Cumberland Prevention Coalition helps keep the county's residents safe from addiction, whether it be to drugs, alcohol or tobacco. Coalition Project Coordinator Candice Beck and Older Adult Prevention Specialist Emily White told the club last week that overall, 50.5% of students say they have not talked with at least one of their parents about the dangers of tobacco, alcohol or drug use in the last 12 months. Not only does the coalition work with schools and students on preventing addiction, it also works with older adults who, when taking opioids for pain, could become addicted. The coalition meets monthly to determine where best to take their messages, they said. The coalition has offices on Livingston Road in Crossville, and is funded through grants and donations. Part of their funding comes from state money from the settlement with Purdue Pharma over opioid addiction, they said.
