NEW ROANE STATE CAMPUS DIRECTOR INTRODUCES HIMSELF TO CLUB

Dewaye McGhee spent 20 years teaching in the Cumberland County schools before taking over as the new Cumberland County campus director at Roane State. He told the club last week that there is much going on at our local campus, including the addition of a new science wing for the associate degree in nursing program the school is starting. Students will be able to get the education needed to become registered nurses. He said the school also has a program in chemical engineering technology that qualifies students in that field to assist chemical engineers and earn a decent salary by the time they are 20 years old. A similar program in nuclear engineering technology is coming to campus in the spring of 2025. About 2,000 job opportunities in East Tennessee in that field are coming, he said. The Roane State system will also hold a symposium titled "The Future of Work: Future-proofing the Workforce of 2030" from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. March 14 at the O'Brien Theatre on the Roane County campus.
