COUNTY CODE ENFORCEMENT DEPARTMENT SET UP

Recently, the Cumberland County Commission set up a code enforcement department for new construction.

Department Director Josh Selby told the club last week that the department, which enforces the 2018 building code, is focusing on new construction now, but he expects eventually to also inspect remodels and other changes to existing structures.

Before the department was created, only the city of Crossville had a code enforcement department. Now, the county department uses the Crossville city codes from 2018 (the latest established) for the unincorporated areas of the county.

So far, no permits have been rejected, and no contractor or homeowner has failed an inspection, he said.

The code office is located at 1760 S. Main St., Crossville, where the county clerk's office is. More information about the department is available on the county Web site, under Mayor's Departments.

Here are some updates on other critical areas. If you have more information please let me know!

- **Food** - Paul is working on confirming our plans for food. Richard has volunteered to help Paul.
 - **Water Donations** - We are still working on securing donated water bottles for the event.
 - **CCHS Culinary Cookies** - We have confirmed with CCHS that they will do the heart-shaped cookies again.
- **Fliers to Schools** - We will be sorting the fliers at 11 a.m. at the Depot. If you can come help it should only take about 20-30 min. The fliers are printed, and the letter is approved by the Director of Schools. Brooke will make sure the fliers get delivered this week.
- **Photographer** - First National Bank has graciously agreed to provide not only the souvenir photos, but they will be at the event to take the pictures, print photos on-site and have them ready for guests to take home. They will also do some advertising on their digital billboard for us over the next few weeks.
- **Giveaway Bags** - Ginny had purchased the supplies for the giveaway bags. She and her husband will put them together and bring them to the dance. If she needs help she will let us know.
- **Tickets & Ticket Sales** - Tickets are in! We need to number those, and then we will deliver them to the locations for sale. We on track to have tickets on sale the first full week of February at the same locations as last year (FirstBank, SmartBank, The Chamber and Weichert Realty)
- **Social Media/Marketing** - An event has been created on FB. We need a social media/marketing volunteer(s). This work is posting updates on the dance, ticket sales and sponsor recognition posts. Additionally, this person/group will work with the Chronicle and other media outlets to promote the dance.
- **Security** - We are reaching out to CPD to confirm security for the dance.
- **Face Painting** - We will need some volunteers to actually face paint this year. We need at least 6 face painters to make this work. All supplies are provided.
- **Sponsor Thank You Notes** - Annually, we give a handwritten thank you note to all our sponsors. We need a volunteer or two that can write those thank-you notes.
