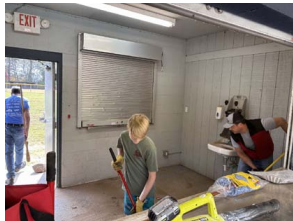


## Service Above Self Cleaning up the Rotary Facility
