'D-Lo' Furlow Shares His Passion With Us On XHunger Program

Derrick Furlow, aka D-Low, a former Tennessee Vol football player, today is the Executive Director of **XHunger.** On

Wednesday he shared his vast knowledge of this issue. It was an eye-opening message.

XHunger helps more than 20 food pantries in our local area. They've held 575 events to date and raised over \$200,000 since the beginning. "And every bit of this



has been done with only volunteers," he said. The organization opened in Knoxville on August 27, 2010.

"We are partners with area food pantries, food banks and similar organizations to help provide their two greatest needs: volunteers and funding," Furlow explained. "We do this by providing volunteers to serve the pantries and organizations to help meet their goals in serving those with food hunger issues. Area fundraising events are created to reach those who wish to volunteer and to bring awareness to our non-profit partners about their needs to help those with food needs."

In 2022 they had their first paid position, which was an executive director. When she left, Furlow took over this non-profit. In 2023 they had an XHunger Scholarship worth \$10,000 they split between high school and college programs.




