Once the paper towels are completely soaked, pull the cardboard middle out, which will also lift the first paper towel - now they will pop up just like regular cleaning wipes!

Last Week's Program

College Founders Scholarship & ORHS Virtual Graduation

The meeting began with Beth Heller speaking on the behalf of the East Tennessee Foundation. Beth gave a brief overview of what they do and how they monitor the endowment funds. While they handle college scholarships, ETF gives generously to the community for the betterment of everyone through the East Tennessee Fund and Neighbor to Neighbor Fund.

Next, Scott Smith introduced the College Founders Awards, along with a brief introduction of this year's winners, Corrine Bailey and Meghan Campbell.

Corrine Bailey was our first winner of the College Founders Scholarship. Corrine plans to work towards a degree in social work, with a minor in Spanish. She believes that her interest in Spanish as a 2nd language will help her to help others throughout her career as she strives to provide others with opportunities and make a positive impact in the world.

Meghan Campbell shared her diverse interests with the club. Meghan wants to minor in music and major in environmental science. She has been creative throughout school, playing the violin, dabbling in creative writing, and performing in many plays, yet she has fallen in love with the idea of microorganisms. Her current plans are to pursue studies in water conservation at Tennessee Tech University.

Following the awards, Martin McDaniel shared with us what has been going on at Oak Ridge High School for their virtual graduation celebration. Originally, graduation had been scheduled for May 28th before COVID-19 ruined all plans. To give our students the best graduation experience possible Martin and others spent 5 days filming graduates walking across a stage with their parents present to see them. After 1000s of editing hours, the compilation was ready, and a



virtual watch party was held with relatives from 1000's of miles away to witness this historical event. No small detail went uncared for; even dirt from Blakenship Field was brought in to add to the ambiance of the event.
