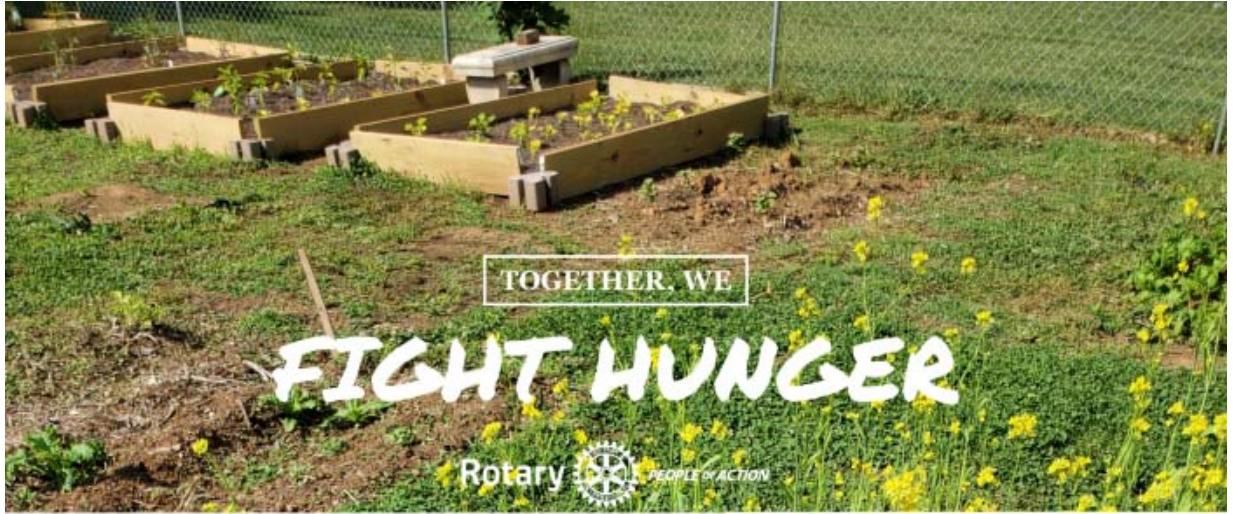

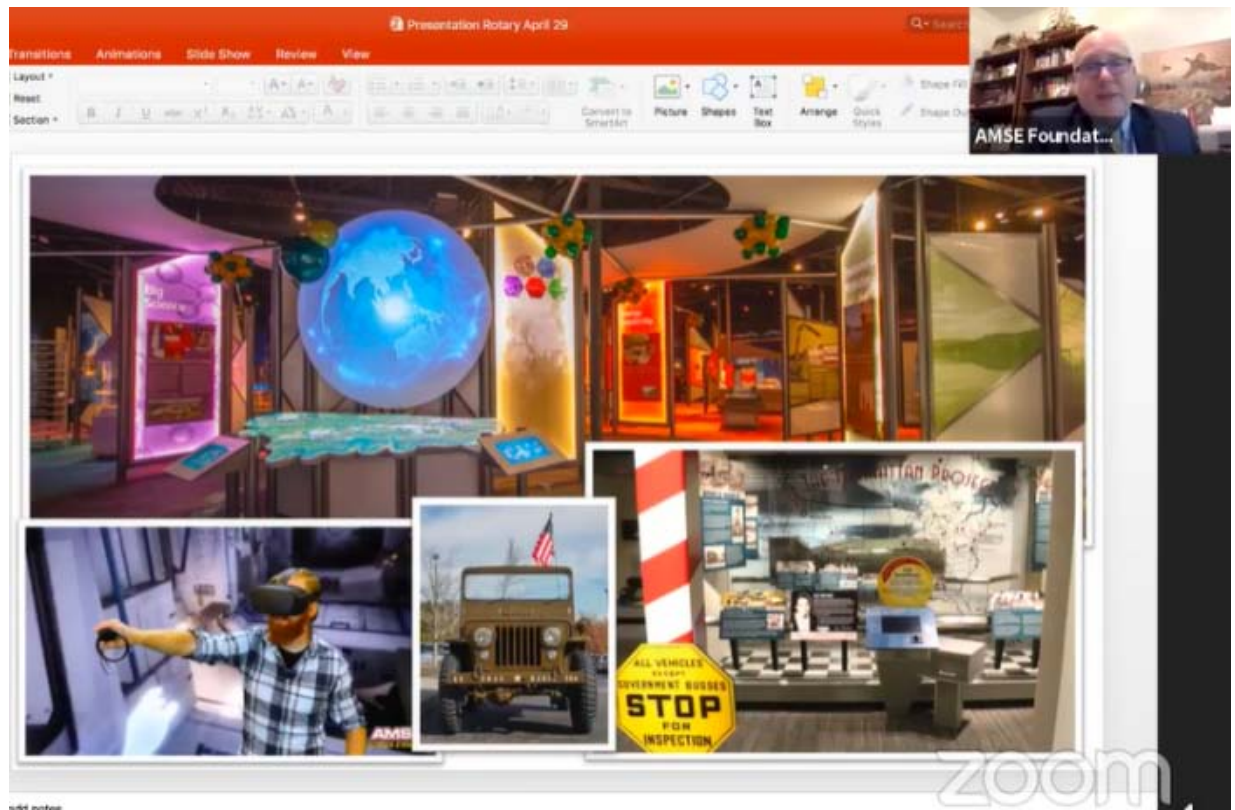
### Interact - Focus on Seniors
