**Ann Mostoller: Legal Update for Wills, Power of Attorney, Trusts and More**

Ann Mostoller has practiced law in Tennessee since 1974 after graduating from the University of Tennessee School of Law. Alongside the late Dorothy Stulberg, Ann founded the law firm of Mostoller and Stulberg, now known as Mostoller, Stulberg, Whitfield, Allen and Tippett.

Ann’s main areas of practice include wills, powers of attorney, conservatorships, and probates. She serves on the trustee panel for the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Tennessee - a role she has held since 1988.

She is licensed to practice law in the state of Tennessee, the U.S. District Court for the Eastern Division of Tennessee, the Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals and the U.S. Supreme Court.

Ann attended Brown University and received her bachelor’s degree in International Relations in 1963. After graduation, she worked for several years at the Center for International Affairs at Harvard University in Boston.



**Last Week's Program**

**Frannie Hamrick: Medicare - Fact & Fiction**

What an informative meeting Frannie presented! What

is Medicare? Medicare is the Federal health insurance program for people 65 and older. What is Part A? Part A covers inpatient hospital stays. Most people do not pay a premium for Part A. What is part B? Part B covers certain doctor services, outpatient care, medical supplies, and preventive services. There is a monthly premium of a minimum of \$165 for Part B. Part C, Medicare Advantage Plans, is privatized insurance usually provided by a limited network of providers, as seen on television ads by JJ Walker and Joe Namath, which may cover additional items and cost more or less. What is Part D? Part D covers prescription drug costs that Medicare does not cover. Part D has different premium prices depending on coverage. What is TRICARE For Life? TRICARE For Life is for people who have Part A and Part B and provides comprehensive health care coverage. Frannie recommends, if you have TRICARE For Life do not switch to any Advantage Plan. As you just read, all of this can be confusing. That is where Frannie and other insurance companies can help and find a plan that benefits you and your lifestyle. Frannie also said that couples could have two different plans based on medical conditions, health, and age, to mention a few factors, so it may be best to check with the experts.
