Transportation 4 All Grant

Friday, October 4th from 1:30 to 4:30 will kick-start our Transportation 4 All district grant. Rotary Club of Oak Ridge, in partnership with Kickstand Knoxville, Emory Valley Center, and United Way of Anderson County will be presenting individuals with low incomes and special needs with a series of both electric-assist and full pedal-powered two-wheeled transportation that will provide them with an increased level of independence and dignity.

This event will present the recipients with the provided bicycles and provide them with training and supplies to be able to operate them safely and care for and maintain them appropriately. Rotarians have provided the funds, vision, and organization for this project, while Kickstand has provided their expertise in working with, training on, and maintaining bicycles. United Way has helped with additional organization and helped us find appropriate individuals whose unique situation will best benefit from receiving these bikes. Emory Valley Center will host the event and has been a large part in helping to select appropriate recipients as well.

Several Rotarians who have been involved in organizing this project will be in attendance and several additional slots are available to join in and support this project on the day of the presentation.
