









**Flatwater Tales Storytelling Festival Returns June 7 & 8 to Oak Ridge**

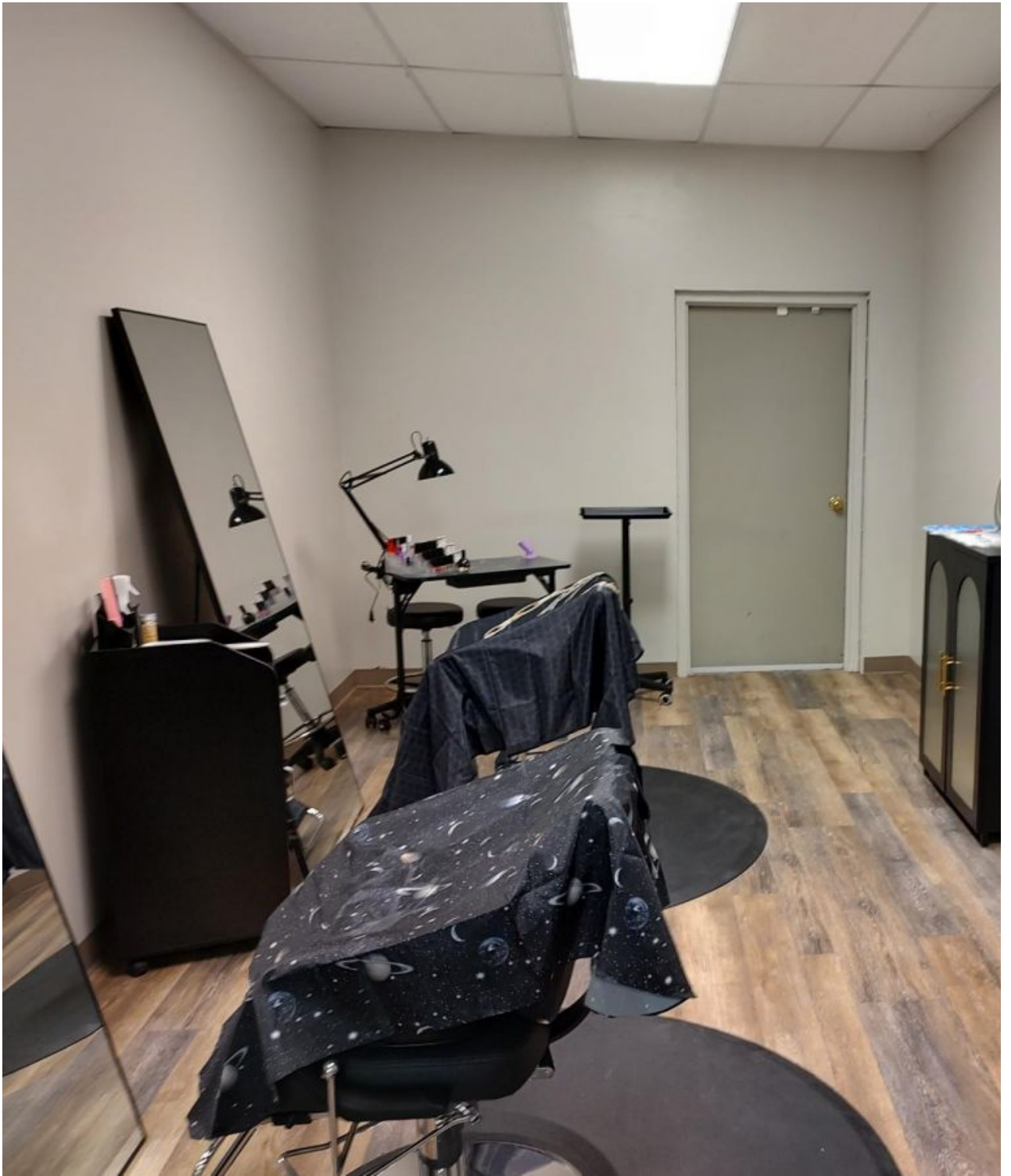

## April 2024 Polio Update

Below is a brief polio update on Rotary's #1 priority - The Global Eradication of Polio.

As of April 10<sup>th</sup> there were 4 confirmed cases of polio in 2024, two (2) in Afghanistan, and two (2) in Pakistan. During the same period last year we only had 1 case, so we're not off to a very good start. Another concern is that there were 17 positive environmental samples reported in the past week. Five (5) in Pakistan and twelve (12) in Afghanistan. On a positive note, this is the first time in several months

· Did you know.. The PolioPlus Society was created to encourage Rotarians to commit to a minimum annual donation of \$100 to the PolioPlus Fund until polio is entirely eradicated.

District 6780 Rotarians have always given generously to the PolioPlus Fund, with hundreds exceeding the \$100 threshold year after year, so why not make it official? Our district currently has 189 PolioPlus S
