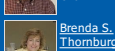

The "Linda Brown Rotarian of the Year" Award is an honor given by the Oak Ridge Breakfast Rotary Club to one or more members who have served the club with distinction during the Rotary Year. It is given annually and carries a donation to the Rotary Foundation or ORBRC Foundation on behalf of the honoree or his/her designee. Active and Honorary Members of ORBRC are eligible.
