## Project Cure - Volunteers Needed

The objective if Project C.U.R.E. is to gather excess medical supplies, collect them at a central location, package and send them to needy medical installations in third world countries around the world. This is a National Program that is supported by Rotary and is conducted from collection points around the country. Nashville, TN has one of those collection points and it located at less than a 2-hour drive from Tullahoma. The Tullahoma Noon Rotary Club has supported this program for many years. Currently the local contributors of medical supplies are Tennova Health Care (Harton Hospital) and Partners for Healing.

The program is managed with a project leader (Mike Greene) who serves as a single point of contact for the program and a number of volunteers responsible for picking up and delivering the supplies to the collection point. The program operates on a monthly basis. The program manager when notified by the contributor that the supplies are available then notifies the volunteer for that month. This monthly volunteer picks up the supplies and delivers them to the C.U.R.E. collection point in Nashville. This is located at 2300 Clifton Ave, Nashville, TN. The operating hours of this collection point are Monday - Thursday (9:00 AM to 3:00 PM); Friday (9:00 AM to 12:00 Noon). We are looking for volunteers to cover deliveries.
