### South Jackson Civic Center

Joining us for the September 9th meeting will be Greg Gressel, Chairman of South Jackson Civic Center. South Jackson Civic Center was formed in 1977 to "Save South Jackson", a grass-roots effort to halt the destruction of the South Jackson School. Nestled in the core of the building is Tullahoma's first public school built in 1886. They opened the doors as the South Jackson Civic Center in January, 1979 with their first performance. South Jackson Civic Association has operated for the past forty years as a presenting organization, museum, and community resource serving the Middle Tennessee counties of Coffee, Moore, Franklin, Bedford, and Warren. The Civic Center contains rehearsal facilities, conference and meeting rooms, a 400-seat auditorium, full stage with proscenium arch and a local history museum.



South Jackson Civic Association maintains and operates the Civic Center with a full-time Coordinator, a part-time Assistant Coordinator, a 10-member Executive Board whose job is to determine policy and finance, a 12-member Operations Committee which manages the day-to-day operations of the facility, the Mitchell Museum and the Friends of South Jackson, a volunteer group.
