Upcoming Rotary District 6780 Events

There are two important Rotary District 6780 events coming up in August. The first event is the annual Pack the Park to End Polio Now with the Tennessee Smokies on Tuesday, August 6th. This will be the last Pack the Park to End Polio Now at the Smokies Stadium in Kodak as the new stadium being built in Knoxville will open for the 2025 season. The Smokies will be playing the Chattanooga Lookouts with the game starting at 7:00 PM. Tickets are \$15/person, with \$6.50 from each ticket sold going to The Rotary Foundation PolioPlus Fund. Each ticket will also include a \$6.00 stadium credit voucher to be used at concessions or stadium vendors. Please let Devrin know if you will be attending the game, and he will get the game vouchers from the District. Please pay the Club for any tickets.

The second event is the Vibrant Clubs workshop on Saturday, August 10th, at Pellissippi State Community College's Hardin Valley campus in Knoxville. This is an informational half-day (morning only) free event open for Club leaders, committee chairs, and members to learn more about Rotary as it applies to their role and the District. 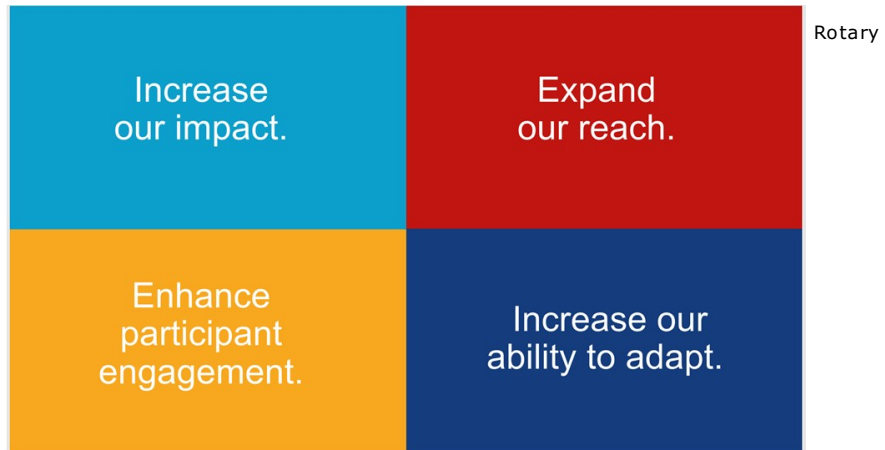
